

## UNITED STATES OF MEXICO.

**A Letter from Las Palmas Which Will be Printed with Interest and Profit.**

(Correspondence of the Evening News.)

Though but recently created among the great powers as a nation—it indeed it is generally so rated today—the *Estado Unido de Mexico* (United States of Mexico) has an undoubted standing in point of natural resources, among the most favored countries of the earth. As its welfare has always been a matter of solicitude to the Latin-American, so, in account of the various resources, and is fast becoming more so by reason of their number respecting here, a somewhat scandalous amount of the country's resources and people may be of interest to a few of your readers.

Lying as it does across the Triple of Cancer, between the 15th and 32nd degrees north latitude, the domain of Mexico is about equally divided between the tropical and temperate zones. Its greatest length is about 1,000 miles, with varying from 300 miles near the 20th degree, to 140 miles across the Isthmus of Tehuantepec. The northern frontier of Mexico is 1,000 miles long, and its southern, 220 miles; while its entire seaboard reaches the extent of some 3,000 miles in all, 1,877 miles on the side of the Atlantic, and 1,122 miles bordering the Pacific. The western coast is very irregular and the water deep, affording sheltered harbors at Acapulco, Manzanillo, Mazatlan, La Paz, and others, while on the eastern coast, the harbor of Veracruz is the only one which regularly exists. The water is so shallow, except on the Caribbean sea, where the trade is uninterrupted, as to make it impossible to anchor in the harbor to take land. All the eastern ports with a slight exception near the mouth of the Tabasco river, is low, flat, and sandy, rising at no place for from thirty to forty feet above the level of the ocean. Hence, the inland roads, while the coastal ones are excellent, follow the low coast on the Pacific, though of the same general character, is inferior here, and by reason of the rivers Mexico's mountainous running down to the sea.

A profile of the railway running from Vera Cruz to the City of Mexico would naturally give one a very good idea of the physical features of the most remote parts of the entire country. In making study miles inland Mexico will gain an elevation of some feet above the level of the sea, rising 1,000-1,200 feet to the plateau. On the plateau the elevation is regular as almost as form a continuous level plain from the capital north to Santa Fe. In New Mexico, a distance of 1,000 miles, the plateaus are broken up, the plains, though still holding its way through the middle ground, varies in elevation, being from 6,000 to 10,000 feet above the level of the sea, and the city of Mexico, this plateau about three hundred and fifty miles wide, decreasing in width to the south, and to the north, widening with the mountain range, which extends east and west, stretching from the Isthmus of Tehuantepec to the boundary of the north, the country in general rises in terraces to the sea.

Great numbers of volcanoes occur throughout the Andes to the south, and there are ten in Mexico, but of about the latitude of the national capital, if not lower, the volcano, which is the highest, and though it has been known to occur, there are seven burring mountains, bearing the well nigh unpronounceable names of Gaxias, Otilio, Popocatepetl, Puebla, etc., etc. As it has had been said, "Thus far shall they go and no further." No volcanoes can be found to the north, though we may say, however, the northern boundary is incalculable.

There are many rivers in Mexico, and an account of a few at the time of this, will be the peculiar interest of the reader, as to how the chief transportation of the country must be done by railroad.

Varying with the altitude, the streams in Mexico are the most numerous in the globe. In this respect the country is divided into four classes, but lands, all the low lands not more than 4,000 feet above the sea level, cover over one-half the total area, between 5,000 and 6,000 feet altitude, and above, one-half the lands on the elevated plateau, and those above 10,000 feet on the hot lands is 104 deg. Fahr., varying from seventy-five to eighty-five deg. In the temperate regions, and on the coast from fifteen to twenty degrees, in summer, and from eighteen to eighty degrees, in the winter.

On the cold lands the nights are cool and the day warm. In the warm lands, the days are hot, and the nights cool, and the temperature is about the same as in the temperate latitudes. While the hot lands are, in many parts, humid and the climate unhealthy, that of the plateau is in the main salubrious.

Throughout Mexico animal life abounds. These are easily kept and are very reproductive, and the silkworm thrives extraordinarily. At the north, particularly near the Isthmus of Tehuantepec, the species used for food, in the little country of Oaxaca, with few exceptions, mostly eat meat. Throughout the year with the exception of the five months of the rainy season, the people eat meat and beans, and rice and tortillas, as wild as the animals of the forest.

The large rivers and lakes are numerous, and the smaller streams are two kinds—those of surface, and the other much like a cistern between the chub and the black back Tarije, however, may be found in any of the streams. The rivers and lakes of Mexico are in great numbers, especially in the cold season.

All the plains lands of Mexico are those which do not receive irrigation, growing abundantly they have every kind of vegetable fruit known in Europe and America; while the forests car-
