But not for "Woman's Rights" to plead or claim— Not that, in Zion, I should blush to name.

I have apologies to offer here. For gentle ladies who disclaim their sphere.

Having obtained enough of truthful light, To see life's strange perversions of the right:

They seek with noble, yet misguided aim, Corruption and abuses to reclaim:

But all their efforts to remove the tares Are only making matters worse and worse.

They could as well pluck without a key, A choker of the date or rind of the peach.

Without the holy priesthood, 'tis at most, Like breaking bills in absence of the post.

No more of this! I'll speak of woman now When inspiration's power, the mind endow—

Where ruins are given to reanimate the earth— To try all textures and to prove all worth:

And what is woman's calling? where her place? Is she destined to honor or disgrace?
