

WOMEN AT FOOTBALL

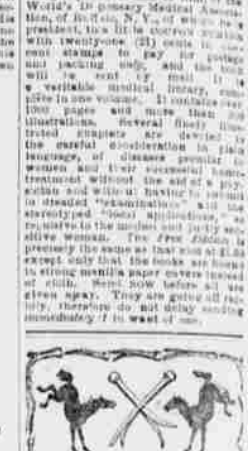
