Central Organization of One Hundred Democratic Women.

SCANDINAVIAN REPUBLICANS MEET.

Republican Women Assembly at the Grand Opera House This Afternoon—General Political Platform.

About fifty Democratic women met in the parlors of the Grand Opera House yesterday afternoon, pursuant to a call made by Judge Powers.

The meeting was called to order by the judge who stated that the object of it was to form a committee of women to assist in the work of the campaign, its outline the work before them and secured them that much of the success of the party in the coming election, would depend upon them. He wanted a committee of 100 appointed who would act as a central organization, and then each of these 100 would be asked to furnish the names of 10 women who would work under their direction. This would form a body of 1,000 women fully organized and working in connection with the campaign of the Democratic committee.

CONTRACTORS' CLAIMS.

On the Gravelly sewer argued before the Board of Public Works.

At a meeting of the board of public works held last evening the claims of Contractors Matheson, Winkerson and Burns for extra work done on the sewer were argued before.

Attorney F. L. Williams appeared in behalf of the contractors and in a lengthy discussion read into evidence in support. They were substantially as follows:

Claim No. 1, excess of cement necessary, \$2,000; No. 2, mortar in excavation and back filling, \$1,000; No. 3, excess of cement, \$5,440; No. 4, extra work, \$2,000; No. 5, extra labor, \$1,500; No. 6, extra labor, \$1,500; No. 7, extra plaster, \$1,000; No. 8, extra gravel, \$1,000; No. 9, extra material, \$1,000; No. 10, sub-contractors' bills, \$750; No. 11, the loss of the sewer, \$1,000.

Mr. Williams of the board, that he would have the matter left free from litigation, but that he would like a compromise made to be effected and the matter dropped of with honor.

Judge Marshall, who appeared for the board, asked for time in which to give the matter thorough consideration, after which the meeting adjourned.
