THE WESTERN UNION TELEGRAPH LINE.

Last Night's Dispatches.

EASTERN.

Settled at Last.

WASHINGTON, 15.—The Sec-
retary of State, to-day, sent to the
Senate the correspondence between
this and the Spanish government
relative to the claim for indemnity
for the *Virginia* affair. It is quite
voluminous, comprising the com-
plete diplomatic history of the af-
fair. The result of the negotiations
was that Spain consented to all the
demands of the U. S., and agreed
to pay \$80,000 in gold uncondition-
ally, the money to be distributed
by the U. S. government without
any accountability to Spain for the
sum not claimed by the latter.

The case in the settlement of a similar
claim of England, Minister Cus-
hing telegraphed, March 12th, that
this country was to be paid \$100,000
on the 10th, and that the ratification
was signed on the 11th, and that
he had sent the same by express.

No Mining in the Black Hills.

It is the determination of the
government to secure to the Sioux
Indians all their treaty rights in
reference to the Black Hills coun-
try, therefore all persons will be
prohibited from going there, and all
new claims will be required to be
made until the Indian title is extin-
guished, which the government will en-
deavor to consummate at the earliest
practicable moment.

**Resigned—Letter From the Vice
President—Confirmed.**

Leroy Tuttle, the assistant U. S.
treasurer, has resigned.

Vice President Wilson has writ-
ten a long letter concerning the
casting vote on the country bill. He
endorses the bill, and says it
could not have been taken from the
treasury more than a few days
ago, and that it would have cost
millions of dollars in aid, and not more
than ten or twelve millions in the
next two years, and could not affect
the credit of the government. The
Vice President has also written a
letter of apology for his casting
vote.

The Senate has confirmed Na-
thaniel McLean, an assistant ad-
miral, with the rank of Lt. Col.;
this appointment has been made
with the view of placing him
on the retired list.

Terrible Storm.

CORINTH, Miss., 15.—A severe
rain and hail storm passed over this
section last night. The town of
Brent was nearly destroyed; four
persons were killed, and many
others were seriously wounded. The
waters are fast subsiding.

Fatal Accident.

INDIANAPOLIS, 15.—A chimney
of the Capital City rolling mill, 96
feet high, blew down this morning;
it was a very old one, and the
boiler was crushed and killed.

The Avenger of Blood.

ST. LOUIS, 15.—Last fall a little
son of Robert Boatwright, while
playing with a number of boys, was
killed by a bullet thrown by a
man named Charles Woodson, one
of the boys; to-day, while Wood-
son's trial was in progress, another
son of Boatwright, aged 16, ap-
peared in court, and said: "I saw
you killed my brother and I will
kill you," he drove a butcher's
knife to the hilt in Woodson's ab-
domen, inflicting a slight wound, and
is believed a mortal wound; Boat-
wright was arrested.

Later.—The boy Woodson, stab-
bed by the son of Boatwright, is
now said not to be fatally wound-
ed; Woodson is a colored boy, and
the son of a noted colored preacher
in this city.

LONDON, 15.—Immense crowds
continued to-day, to the meetings
of Moody and Sankey; to-night
over twenty thousand people
were present, and thousands
of converts were reported. In the
vicinity of the hall were choked

Milan were also nominated.
