

PIOCHE NOTES.

From the Record of Sept. 30—
An honest miner writes to us and we can tell him why so many worthless mines situated near Virginia are dealt in with avidity and quoted at prices that far exceed the real value, that is to say, they have any at all. Our correspondent says, and truly, that many of those so-called mines have never raised ore enough in 24 hours to pay their miners, and while Pioche mines, that are producing more or less bullion all the time are away down out of sight. That is all we but then our correspondent would assure us that these mines are located some where round if not on the Comstock, and that magic name is what gives them their apparent value. As to our Pioche stocks, we shall have to bid our time. Every mining camp has its wives and daughters, and none has experienced greater vicissitudes or changes of fortune than those situated on the Comstock. But a few years since and Gold Hill were only to be mentioned by Platters who would dispute possession with the bats and owls that were expected to inherit the habitations of the dwellers on the Comstock. Now see what Virginia is, and yet there are only three or four mining camps in the whole outfit. Just so it will be with Pioche. Now is the time for our tribulation. These smarmies down in San Francisco, who make all the noise, are the ones to get blacked. They shake their heads knowingly when Pioche stocks are mentioned. Oh no. They won't do; the bottom has fallen out, etc. It is no use to point to the millions taken out, the dividends paid, the favorable prospects; all no; nothing will do. The stockholders, too, are not without the last "A". Now, the fact is, that if all signs that experience and judgment can detect, do not fail, the mines on the great Pioche lead will, in the course of a few months come to better ore than ever, and in larger and more regularly distributed quantities. True, this may not be the case, no one can see into the ground. But for all that, facts and present appearances are all in favor of our hypothesis. That the lead pays well \$500 feet underground, nearly a quarter of a mile south of the Raymond Mine shaft, is an acknowledged fact. Another fact is that between No. 3 (Meadow Valley) and the Lighter shaft, a body of ore has been found on the 1200 foot level, that carries much metal, but could not be followed down on account of the want of light and air. This is the Meadow Valley, in its lower level, far east from this point, another body of good ore has been found. All these things are indicative of what lies further down the ledge falling out, we have not yet reached the best of it. But as a lady correspondent said the other day, we are not just in the same situation that Virginia was, and thank heaven we have just the same man Sharon to help us out. If he will stick to us we have no doubt that matters will turn out all right. And then these same old stock sharers in San Francisco will be parking round on their high-heeled boots and say: "I told you so." Those fellows are good at hind sights, but not worth a button as a pilot.
