A Dangerous Encounter in a Mine at Virginia City.

FATAL ACCIDENT AT GLENWOOD.

Edward Smith, a Male Witness in a Murder Case, Accused Suicide—Hester and Hubbell.

The Lander, Wyo., Copper mine has been discovered by Mr. Gifford, a local miner, who has been working in the mine for some time. The mine is located in the Lander valley, and is said to be one of the richest in the state.

James Howard, an employee of the Lander, was killed by a falling rock in the mine. The rock fell from the ceiling of the mine, and struck Howard on the head. He was killed instantly.
