

## SECOND MEETING OF CONFERENCE

Addresses by Elders F. M. Lyman, John Henry Smith and Heber J. Grant.

### KINGDOM SAFE IN AMERICA.

President Lyman Declares Latter-day Saints Will be Respected for Their Integrity, Honesty and Loyalty.

At the second meeting of conference, Elder F. M. Lyman of the council of the apostles, was the first speaker. He spoke of the restoration of the gospel to earth in modern times through the Prophet Joseph Smith, and continued:

"The work of the Lord is so firmly fixed that we are not subjected to many surprises from within, and few from without. The Church is but young, only about 28 years old, but it has made remarkable and steady progress; and notwithstanding many have left it, and lost the faith, the Church continues to grow and has made and continues to make wonderful progress.

"Every member of the Church is expected to be honest, upright, and true; and that to the fact that this duty is carried out is largely due the growth of the Church. It is an individual work, and the people are individually interested in it."

President Lyman touched upon the subject of home training for children. "Make your homes so comfortable and desirable, so that the children may desire to go home when they are away, and that they feel better and find more congenial society at home than abroad. Children will never go astray when they are with their parents."

"Boys and girls should be taught to work, not so they be injured by heavy work, but with suitable tasks which will train their brains and hands. There is more danger in idleness than there is in work. The children should also be taught to value money, and to spend the money they earn with wisdom. In so doing the boy or girl will become independent and self-reliant in business matters."

"We are here but for a few years, and it should be the desire of the saints to secure the respect of all men by their honesty, integrity and loyalty to God and our government. For this is a land of liberty and the kingdom of God is safe under its protection. There shall rule no king in this land of liberty, until He whose right it is to rule comes in his glory. The Lord has set a purpose to maintain his people in this country and he is in touch with the Latter-day Saints and will be appreciated among the people of the world, on account of their peculiarity in the line of honesty, uprightness, and loyalty, and a race of men will spring up from the Latter-day Saints who shall be remarkable for physical and mental and spiritual strength and who will be appreciated among the children of men. The Church is spreading and new members are being added constantly in all quarters. The quality of our missionaries is also being improved, more experienced men are being sent out, and in the course of a year or two it will be found that our missions will be much improved, and the results will spread with still greater rapidity than it has done heretofore."

The chief mission of the Latter-day Saints is to preach the gospel of the Son of God. They should thank the Lord for the restoration of the plan of salvation in the latter days. It is a remarkable gift to be in possession of the gospel. For ages the world had only the dead letter. With the natural spirit of man, the plan of salvation cannot be found out—men with their wisdom cannot comprehend the truth. But with the Spirit of God it is made plain. The Lord has revealed to the Prophet Joseph Smith and his successors the plan of salvation. This work will accomplish what the Father has designed. The integrity of the men in authority in the Church is manifested among the people. The union spoken of by President Smith is true in the stakes, wards, and organizations throughout the Church. The stakes, wards and auxiliary organizations are being well taken care of. For difficulties are ever come up to the first presidency. Injustice has scarcely if ever been done by the stake presidencies and high councils. The stakes take care of their own troubles, and the people are proving themselves thoroughly capable of doing so.

They go forth and labor for the salvation of the living, while others stay home and work for the dead. The temples should be filled every day that they are open. Salvation is only for those who believe and repent of their sins, whether they be living or dead. The blood of the Savior extends to all mankind, but is only efficacious to those who accept the principles of the gospel.

### ELDER JOHN HENRY SMITH.

Elder John Henry Smith of the council of the apostles said in part: "I have enjoyed in large measure the good instruction and advice that has fallen from the lips of President Lyman this afternoon. I believe that a feeling is growing in the souls of the saints of this country and he is in touch with the gospel and its forward movement in the world. They are glad to hear of the progress of the cause we love, and I trust that such shall be the case until the obligations of the Latter-day saints to preach the gospel shall have been discharged in all honor. That we may be fully successful among that class of men and women considered more scholarly than the mass of their fellows, it will be necessary for us to become better qualified in this direction ourselves. In the introduction of the work some very choice men and women were so imbued with the spirit and inspiration that they could go into the world and though they had had only limited opportunities for securing educational advantages, yet they have preached Jesus Christ and Him crucified with convincing power. And mingling with these classes who had had all the advantages of research and education, their choice spirits were able to present the truths of the gospel of the lowly Nazarene they were able to use such argument as to convince the man of superior learning. There is no reason why the love and mercy of our heavenly Father should not give unto any man the revelations of His mind and will in relation to those divine truths which He has revealed, and the evidences of His handiwork should leave such impress upon the individuals that the power of truth and conviction should be carried to their minds."

"It was the revelation of the divine will that declared to the boy prophet that mankind was in darkness. It was the direct communication to an untutored boy that opened up the way of knowledge and of salvation to the human race, and unraveled the mysteries of the universe and the understanding of the angels that we see about us today. The wonders about us are only the evidences of the touch of the divine spirit upon the children of men, and through these revelations men are able to work wonders and perform marvelous things. These are the workings of divine influence, and lead us to exclaim with one of old, 'What hath God wrought?'"

Elder Smith detailed a conversation with a gentleman in California, in which he saw a touch of the divine spirit; a man who was willing to give heaven the credit for his achievements, and to say with Moses, "What hath God wrought?"

Nothing but satisfaction should be found among the people. Strife and malice should cease. The Latter-day Saints have received a gem of gems, the gospel of the Redeemer. God writes in the soul of every man and woman who follows the Master's teachings. Each individual should perform his part.

ELDER HEBER J. GRANT.

Elder Heber J. Grant of the council of the apostles, rejoiced at having the opportunity of meeting brethren and sisters in this conference. I have never had any other desire in standing before the people than to impress upon all myself included, the necessity of observing humility, in order that we might all receive of the blessings promised to the doers of the will of God. I believe like the Apostle James, that the blessings of heaven will be poured out upon the people who do the work commanded by our Father.

The speaker told of an instance where a aged widow had overcome the help of the Lord, the use of coffee. This sister told of the benefits which followed this act on her part, and the speaker said he wished every man and woman present could have heard her testimony, for more would make the effort to quit these things.

Elder Grant spoke of the letter written by President Alma O. Taylor of the Japanese mission, which he said would be published on account of the fervent spirit in which it was written, and the value it would be to the various missions.

President M. O. Taylor told a truth when he said it was not what we accumulate that gives us joy, but that which we give out. There is a great blessing comes to us in giving thus accumulating. And so it is in the mission field. Some of the brightest elders have had as their reason for the release that should come to them at the end of their labors, and not what they can do for the kingdom. The thought should be how much we can do for the work, and even to the end of our lives, in the cause of Christ.

"I rejoice in the remarkable work being accomplished in the spread of the gospel," said Elder Grant. "The baptisms in the British mission, under President Penrose, are greater than during the presidency of his predecessor. Elder Penrose is remarkably successful in his own labors and in inspiring faith and diligence on the part of the missionaries. Although he is 75 years of age, the work that he is performing is simply wonderful."

The speaker made a humorous remark as to a statement made of him that his favorite song was "We thank Thee, O God, for a prophet." He said emphatically that he did thank God for a prophet.

The statement has sometimes been made that the Latter-day Saints are better than their religion. Such a condition could not possibly exist, as stated by Elder Joseph S. Wells in the tabernacle a few weeks ago.

Elder Grant referred to most respectful terms to the memory of the late Apostle Joseph T. Tinsdale, and the vacancy that had been caused in the quorum by his taking away. "Brother Tinsdale was full of humility, and a man of God. I never saw him angry, and he was a man who inspired confidence in the breast of everyone with whom he came in contact. I remember when Brother Tinsdale was teaching a little class in Sunday school in an Oregon town, his presence caused the pupils to be brought out. I shed tears as I listened to his beautiful teachings on that occasion, and the love and devotion that he displayed was of an inspiring nature. Elder Tinsdale's funeral was not so well attended as it should have been, and my soul was grieved at the thought that his works were not known or were not appreciated by the people. The thought came to me that people now look after musical entertainments at funeral services rather than to pay respect to the departed."

"Again I say I heard the words of the Apostle James, 'Let us show our faith by our works, by being honest, virtuous and charitable, and walking uprightly before the Lord.'"

Conference was adjourned until 10 o'clock Saturday morning. Closed by singing "We thank Thee, O God, for a prophet." Benediction by Patriarch John Smith.
