THREE PARDONS

His Application is Turned Down And He Must Serve His Sentence of Six Months.

The state board of pardons at yesler-day aftermoon's cession pardoned Louis Grienstelf, Frank White and T. V. Cuney. Grienstelf pleaded guilty and was sentenced to one year for bur-glary, when he was charged with im-morality. So the board pardoned him because of the mixip.
