As Mr. Curtis, the two nights prev-lous, had avoided every question per-taining to the subject, Elder Sanders challenged the answer of 12 questions which he propounded. Mr. Curtis failed to answer them. Mr. Sanders proved his position from every stand-point. The Lord said, in setting the Church in order the first time: (Sec. 124, verse 127) 'II give unto you my servant Brigham Young to be presi-dent over the twelve traveling coun-cil." In section 107, v. 24, it is said, speaking of the Twelve: 'And they form a quorum equal in authority and power to the presidents previously mentioned." "Now." said the speak-er, "when the prophet bestowed all keys, power and authority on the Twelve, he turned to Brigham Young, president of the quorum, and said: 'Upon you I bestow a special key— the key pertaining to the presi-dency."

the key pertaining to the presi-dency." Elder Sanders proved from the Doc-trine and Covenants that the presi-dency of quorums naturally grew out of the quorums themselves, and were ordained by its members. These are some of the points Mr. Curtis avoided. Mr. Curtis, for the negative, claimed that the original Church was rejected in that it had failed to abide in the law in not com-pleting the temple at Nauvoo; that the leaders had fallen from grace and therefore were not accepted by the Lord, necessitating a reorganization; that Brigham Young advocated, the speaker said, was contrary to the commandments of God; that Brigham Young advanced the idea of Adam-God, and permitted and practised many other innovations. These are some of the reasons, contended the speaker, that Brigham Young did not legitimately ascend to the presidency of the Church. All these allegations, however, were so incoherently put to-gether and given as bald statements, without proof, reason or argument, they had little weight with the audi-ance.
