## INDIANS WANT LAND.

Pins and Bartops Club Held a Conference With Gov. Hughes.

## ASKING FOR HIS ASSISTANCE.

To Obtain Pins, Build Roads and Live Like White People, Supporting Themselves.

TUCSON, Ariz., Oct. 17.—A special from Senator Teller agency says Tucson Indians, by request, met the Pins and Bartops Club in their council. There were about fifteen and a large number of Indians present representing over 4,000. At the conference, they told the governor they wanted forming basis of their association adopted to make necessary to small tribe for roads, water to cultivate the lands and wanted to live like white men their own homes and supports to their people. The Pins and Bartops Club were asked to do their best to their request. The policy of the government was acknowledged, so it wanted to help the Indians to self-government. This pleased the Indians. Three Indians have been recently released from prison, Indians said they have received no high degree of education. They will make a formal application to the interior department through their agent, J. C. Young, for assistance of funds.

## PARKER'S PROTESTS A REVOLUTION.

NEW YORK, Oct. 17.—In Parker's speech at last night's meeting he gave the testimony of a Leavenworth man who had received \$200 rent for a part of his house to be used as a voting place, and that he had given the money to the Leavenworth Indians, who had no place to go in the city, so that the "biggest amount of Indian," which was, however, a mere incident to the testimony.

"Helps our Indian," said Mr. Parker, "but I am not going to be responsible for the result." The Indians have been denied the right to vote in the past, and those Indians, if forced to say so, could not help themselves.
