A Killing at Sacramento, California, in Self Defense. A JEALOUS HUSBAND'S CHIEF. Body of Officer John F. Maguire Found in Westlake, Los Angeles—A Clear Case of Murder.

Mr. E. Duncan, who had his skull fractured by a blow with a shovel in the hands of Joseph Griffin, at Denver, Monday, was an officer in the police force.

Last week Jack Harris, of Beaumont, Cal., was with a woman named L. L. Calverton, Harris started after the couple and commenced firing. He failed to strike either man, but Calverton returned the fire and killed his opponent.

About 10 o'clock on Monday night William Christ, a factory of Beaverton, Ore., shot and killed his wife Emma at their home on 12th street.

Charles claims that he had strangled his wife in the night before she was found in the street. The officers, however, found that the woman's face was purple, indicating strangling. They think the pistol had been held close to the woman's head and that she had been shot while sitting down.
