Opinion in the Case of Munns et al vs Loveland et al.

JUDGMENT LOWER COURT UPHOLD.

Opinion delivered by Chief Justice Kane and Justice Minor.

The State Supreme Court handed down an opinion today in the case of Arthur J. Munns and Edwin Jensen, appellants, vs C. C. Loveland, et al, respondents.

The respondents in this case with the exception of C. C. Loveland, who at the time the proceedings were commenced was the sheriff of Baxter county, filed separate suits in justice and common law courts.

Assignment suits were issued and placed in the hands of Sheriff Loveland, who levied upon the goods of the respondents.

After the levy had been made and the goods in possession, the respondents were notified to appear before the justice court.

The trial of the case was had before Judge Holop, who nominated all of the jurors to the grand jury, and after the jury had been sworn, the plaintiff presented a complaint.

The first question taken up by the Supreme court in this case, was not Judge Holop's right in appointing the several defendants, the contention of appellants being that the sheriff should have been notified.

The court held that the attaching creditors were not liable for the acts of the sheriff, unless they interfered in some way.


In an opinion for the court, the liability of a creditor in such a case, is determined by the facts of the case.
