

THE CANVASS.

The canvassing committee who are engaged in tabulating the returns of the election are making excellent progress. August 18 they completed Plute County, and on August 19 began with Rich County. We give the results of today's work up to as late an hour as would allow time to put the tables in type.

Emery county appears to have cast a pretty full vote. This is a rapidly growing county, and its citizens took considerable interest in the election.

In Grand county it appears that the precincts have not yet been given a name, but are designated by numbers. This is a new county, having only been organized at the last session of the legislature, and contains only a few hundred inhabitants.

Garfield is one of the sparsely settled counties. It polled a fair vote.

The vote in Iron county was rather light, and only one precinct officer, a constable in Kanarra, was elected.

Juab county cast a heavy vote. The contest for the office of school superintendent was close, and there were eight candidates for selectman, six of whom received a respectable number of votes.

Kane county cast a light vote and had a remarkable number of candidates for the office of selectman.

Millard county cast a tolerably full vote, and had seven candidates for selectman.

Morgan county did not cast a heavy vote. A coroner was elected.

The voters of Plute county turned out pretty well. Here there seems to have been an unusual number of aspirants for office.

No precinct offices were voted for in Rich county.

San Juan county was partly canvassed, but as there were some precincts from which returns had not been received, it was thought best to hold this county in the hope that the returns might all come in before the canvass is completed.
