Benson Will Destroy Any Further Invasion of Cuba.

New York, April 29.—Another bombardment of Matanzas will probably follow if Gen. Howland makes any attempt to retake the batteries destroyed by Admiral Sampson, says the Associated Press correspondent of the Herald.

Official dispatches from Admiral Sampson received at the navy department today tell of the bombardment. The only explanation is made for the attack on the Matanzas fortifications is that they were discovered. The Spaniards were erecting heavy guns there and had expended to demolish them.

He adds that the Spaniards will be sent back to Matanzas with orders to destroy any new batteries that may be constructed.
