20 Says a Jury Regarding Commissioner Goodwin's Professional Services.

GOOD FOR LA PLATA DISTRICT.

Land Deeds—Mineral Patents—

C. C. Goodwin, U. S. commissioner at Logan, and V. Rapp were engaged a short time ago to render services in a legal way for the A. & A. Mining company. A bill of \$20 was presented but the company could not see that value in the legal information it had gained. Mr. Rapp assigned his claim to Mr. Goodwin, who instituted suit against the mining company for the amount of money. The case came on before a jury at Logan, and resulted in a verdict for the plaintiff. The jurors, however, seemed to incline greatly in the same view as that taken by the A. & A. people, for they dropped the commissioner down with no gentry than by upstaging his professional services at \$1 only. His partner thought it was worth five times as much, and accordingly gave a judgment on that division of the claim for \$5, or \$5 and costs in all against the mining company.

SATISFACTORY SETTLEMENT.

At the meeting of the Sundown and La Plata Mining company held at Logan, Mr. John H. White agreed to give the company a deed for section 11, embracing all of the company's claims in Le Plata mining district, for the amount already paid. The settlement of this important matter is very satisfactory to the company, and creditable to Mr. White, who showed no disposition to force the company to pay heavily, as he might have done.

It is expected that extensive work will be done at La Plata this season, and the most promising claims developed more fully.

SILVER RESOLUTION.

E. R. Light, vice president of the Denver Manufacturers' Exchange and a delegate to the Trans-Mountain conference, has introduced the measure to present in the Congress the following resolution adopted by the exchange at its meeting on May 1:

Whereas, there has been and is a tendency in communities not on the part of manufacturers in the eastern states to ascribe the public sentiment in the Rocky Mountain states in favor of the remonetization of silver, to the fact that such states are silver producers, and

Whereas, such western sentiment in favor of the remonetization of silver arises not alone in the interest of a local industry, but is based on the general principle of policy and in the belief that such remonetization will bring about the revival of agriculture, manufacturing, trade and commerce generally, and

Whereas, the evil effects of the undue and artificial appreciation in the value of gold resulting from the unwise demonetization of silver, are being increasingly recognized by the manufacturing and trading classes of Great Britain and

Whereas, such manufacturing and trading classes of Great Britain are certainly not open to the institution that their sentiment in favor of the remonetization of silver as a money metal is to be accounted for either from their direct or indirect interest in silver mining;

Resolved, That the manufacturers' exchange of Denver, comprising 200 manufacturers throughout Colorado, representing 100 of the mineral producing states of the Eastern and other American states that they investigate the so-called silver question from the business standpoint its effect on trade and prices, believing that such investigation will be of great assistance to the manufacturers and trading classes of the British manufacturers and using their great influence towards helping about the early remonetization of silver.

UTAH LAND CONCERN.

DAIRY'S COTTAGE.

Lieutenant Governor Willis and N. J. Sharp have just returned from Salt Lake, where they went to investigate the meat market that will be opened for copper ore by the new copper plant there. Mr. Sharp stated that, while no complaint has been made, that no one can obtain meat from the market except copper property on the east bank of River in which he is interested. Mr. Eccles made him a very favorable freight rate, and the smaller charge will be paid, and the ore will be shipped to him at a favorable price.
