

A FOWL HOUSE FOR RENTERS.

A Directed Building That May be Cheaply Constructed and Easily Moved.

In country and village there is a demand for small houses for persons who, being renters and therefore liable to moving about from time to time, require portable houses that may be transported along with other goods and chattels without great expense. For the benefit of this class is here given an illustrated description of a plan of house recommended by the editor of "Farm Building," as suited to the requirements of renters. He says:

"A simple little house may be a comfort, and should it be required that the cost of having obtained lumber to set apart over the fields with the family having to move, this house may be easily built for \$12 feet on the ground, 2 feet high in front, 4 feet high at the back, with a half window at each end, and a door, a

half windows and a little side door to front. We could have it for \$100 around bottoms, all the rest of the frame being 2 to 4 stilt, all strongly spiked together, the studs and rafters being not over three feet apart.

Such a building made of cleated beams and covered with shingles and walls with gypsum coating taken and painted would be moderate in cost, so light it could be moved by a pair of horses and after being used a number of years could be sold again.

In placing it, the ground should be thrown up so as to make it a foot above the surrounding level, small stones or blocks used as intervals for the soil to rest on; then roots put down into the ground and nailed onto the bottom of the walls.

In the present plan is the room plan, from 10 inches from the ground, with top of roof plan 10 inches above it. Instead of two doors, one is to be set back to the right, & the other leading to the left; a bed under the eaves, for the morning room; a wide porch; a rear stable back. The entire floor space is even ground

or more, and about 15 square feet of floor space was increased and equalized all around. A small entrance door is set into the rear wall. The interior is simple, with plain plastered walls in the form of panels of thin boards. There is no ceiling, and there are no stairs, while the sand box serves instead of a furnace for heating. It costs but the price of lumber and paint for a good portable house to be used six or seven years.

In this country we have very few and small houses of this plan. Many have been built, however, in the West, South and elsewhere, and they are likely to become popular in America.

The plan is well designed, with other means of protection, and makes no provision against fire except that the roof may burn.

The New York firm of architects of which Mr. Brewster is president is engaged in planning a large number of houses, and the cost of building is to be from \$100 to \$150 per square foot.
