"AMERICAN" PARTY SECURES BONDS

In Election Characterized By Much Wrangling, the Proposition Is Accepted.

MAJORITY IS FIVE HUNDRED

Water Bonds Voted by This Margin With Sewer Bonds Following By a Smaller Lead.

With a total vote of 5,547, which, small as it is, is large for a bond election, the city fathers may now go ahead to issue bonds to the amount of \$600,000 and offer them to the highest bidders.

The water bonds received 3,024 votes and the sewer bonds 2,523 votes, with 2,523 votes against the water bonds and 2,523 votes against the sewer bonds. This left the bonds a majority of 601 for the water, and 350 for the sewer, a number of votes equal to only a small portion of those cast at a single polling place in an ordinary election.

The bonds lost only in the Third ward. They carried in the others with a small majority in the Fourth.

The large vote is accounted for by the fact that so many voters deeply distrust the administration in power and feared to give into its hands a fund of this size just before an election season. The city fathers would be offered for its expenditure in the campaign. Illegal voting, and the determination of the "American" party to carry the bonds at all hazards, and to vote every one who would be forced up to the polls, it is charged, accounts for many of the "aye" votes. The anti-bond committee will canvass the situation in this regard, and decide upon what future action shall be advisable.
