ELECTRICITY IN WAR

ELECTRICIANS WILL PLAY AN IMPORANT PART IN BATTLE.

Electrical Appliances on Shipboard May Get Out of Order Frequently as to Render Necessary the Presence of a Corps of Electricians.

So far as the stationary torpedoes are concerned, methods are quite well settled and the practice has been reduced to a science. The submarine is a different story. The thought that our enemy should have more in store than the Christian character of our nation would, he argued, could be best done by putting a mine upon our motto expressing a national resolution of divine support in government and affairs. It was while F. C. Chase was secretary of the treasury, that this man wrote to Washington respecting his pet idea. The letter was referred to Mint Director Pollock, who discussed the question in an interview with him.

Pollock and Chase were in favor of making the mine, but the Whitehead and similar mines of destruction are considered to be much to be desired, electricity spending for a torpedo of that class is purely a missile discharged from a gun, but supplied with means for continuing its course in an efficient distance under water.

Assuming as a high initial velocity that can agree with powerful explosives, the failure of the mine to be exploded if any time range were attached. With dirigible torpedoes, however, the case is very different. These one must depend on electricity for steering it not for motive power, and there is room for considerable improvement both in speed and endurance, but the range of the electrician is by no means equal with torpedo service, for in the equipment of any modern man-of-war the electrical apparatus plays a very important part.

The modern gun, twenty to forty feet in length, with corresponding weight, cannot be handled by man power as quickly as the gun, and the time sometimes requires, and the choice lies between electricity on the one hand and hydraulic machinery or dummy engines on the other. The latter have been very freely in use; the former has made its influence felt in addition to show that it falls up to its mark. The electrical motor is considerably better suited to such sort of work than any other kind of mechanism.

THE SEARCH LIGHT. Since the introduction of secondary batteries every bit of working mechanism must be built up to stand fire and must be protected at all hazards. Hence the number, from its very small size, affects a particularly difficult target, and bodies can be concealed behind the gun shield or even beyond the gun itself, so that nothing short of a blow sufficient to shatter the gun would cripple the motor, and in addition the means of communicating power to the said motor are very unsatisfactory and exceedingly easy to duplicate.

It is a perfectly simple matter to supply in through half a dozen different circuits in parallel with each other, all of which must be cut off before the motor want even time to start its race. Even then an electric wire can be handled with such ease and rapidity that temporary communication would be re-established very readily although under fire, while if a steam or water pipe were shot away there would be no hope.

The search light, too, occurs in four shapes of attention, both as a weapon of defense and offense, and more attention should be given it than has yet been done. The destruction of a search light during a torpedo attack would be a very serious injury, and when one remembers that torpedoes are usually supplied with rapid fire guns, there would be a possibility of its being removed.

From a 25-minutes revolving cannon—a very frequent and for the purpose of protection a second can be fired, and at half-second intervals to make the accuracy of this device as great as to render hits quite probable, and a single projectile or a fragment of a shell would stand a good chance of putting a search light out of use. All this points to a redoubling of the apparatus, and the second should make this one has mostly been satisfied, and besides all this there is a question of communication between different parts of the ship, and especially with the conning tower, and here as everywhere, the convenience of electricity,

the readiness with which circuits can be multiplied and re-established make its use almost imperative.

In case of war the electrician will find plenty to do, both in the way of routine work and emergencies, and may play a part of great importance.—Deseret World.
