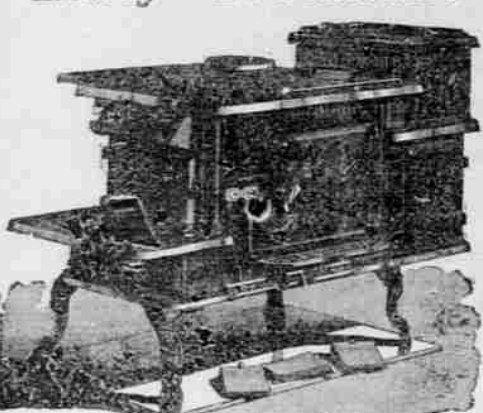

The Senate concurred in resolution
