NEW RAILROAD TO TETON VALLEY.

Oregon Short Line to Develop One of the Most Fertile Spots of Northeastern Idaho — Details of the Route of the Line Which Leaves St. Anthony, Continuing on to Yellowstone Park on the North and Via Marysville to Victor on the South East.

Since the "News" printed the exclusive story of the projected line from Rexburg to Yellowstone Park and the Teton valley this week there have been a number of inquiries regarding land available for homesteaders in the regions to be tapped. There is every indication that before the line is completed the tide of immigration will set steadily for the famous Teton basin. There is plenty of rich land yet to be settled in this district and the opening of the line will afford a market for their heretofore isolated section.

Already have soil experts tested the Teton valley and pronounced it to be one of the best beef growing districts yet encountered. This means that the farmers locating in this section will be able to raise rails, ship them to the factories at Sugar City and realize spot cash for their produce.

The incorporators of the new road are all Oregon Short Line officials and represent the executive, operating, traffic, auditing and engineering departments of the parent system. The principal place of business of the corporation is Pocatello. All save one of the directors reside in Salt Lake, however.

The incorporators are W. H. Bancroft, W. H. Butterfield, W. T. C. Birmingham, P. L. Williams, Wm. Walton, D. E. Burley, C. J. McNitt, T. H. Knickerbocker, T. J. Duddleson, J. A. Reeves.

Articles of incorporation of the new company were filed in Pocatello a couple of days ago and set forth that the purpose for which this corporation is organized is "to construct, build and maintain the following described line of railroad and operate the same by steam or other motive power, together with such branch lines and extensions as may from time to time be deemed desirable and expedient and as may be authorized by law. Also in connection with said line, sale of lines of railroad such lines of telegraph and telephone as may be necessary. The description of the proposed line of railroad follows:

The line begins at St. Anthony, connects with the St. Anthony branch and will extend in a north-easterly direction, passing through the town of Marysville and over the divide in the Rocky mountains by way of Bear River Pass through the section forming the western boundary of the Yellowstone National Park and three miles more or less easterly from Dwysle's hotel, a total distance of about 75 miles.

A line of road will connect at St. Anthony with the line miles east and then about 50 miles south to the town of Victor in Bingham county. The road will run through Bingham and Fremont counties, Idaho, and Gallatin county, Mont.

THIRD TRAGEDY IN A BLACKFOOT FAMILY.

BLACKFOOT, Idaho, Sept. 14.—Last Friday a sad accident happened here that has cast a gloom all over this place. As Jesse, the 8-year-old son of Harry Gekas, attempted to cross the railroad tracks by crawling under a freight car, the train suddenly started, as he was just pulling his left foot out, thus catching his foot, cutting it clean off. The little fellow was immediately taken to the Blackfoot hotel, and local physicians gave him the necessary treatment. He was afterwards taken to a Salt Lake hospital and the doctor's bill account was getting along very well.

Mr. and Mrs. Gekas have certainly had more than their share of ill-luck during the past year, more than enough to take all ambition out of them. First came financial reverses, second, a child was drowned in St. Anthony, and about the same time they lost their one-month-old baby after a stillbirth. Their troubles are now ended in the silence of death.

WEATHER AND CROP REPORT FOR IDAHO.

For the week ending Monday, Sept. 11, 1905. The temperature averaged about 5 degrees above the normal, though in some sections the nights were rather cool. Some local thunderstorms visited limited areas in Bannock and Bear Lake counties on the 4th, too late to be reported in last week's bulletin; in places considerable had accompanied those storms; over the remainder of the state dry weather continued, though there was a marked increase in cloudiness toward the end of the week, and the aspect was at times quite threatening. Water in all streams continues to fall, and smoke from burning forests obscures the view in all parts of the state.

CROPS.

Fruit is maturing rapidly and shipment of all tree fruits except apples is active. Some peach trees in small orchards where protection has been unusually good are very heavily laden, but the crop in open orchards is below average, and many of the peaches now being offered are not of as good quality as those ordinarily produced in the state.

Very little small grain remains to

be harvested, and threshing is well advanced in all but the most elevated districts; reports continue to indicate that the total yield of wheat and oats will be above average, but complaints of shrunken wheat are becoming more general; a small portion of the wheat affected by rust and smut. Corn is maturing rapidly under the influence of the hot dry weather, and some has been cut.

The farmers are all busy at work harvesting their crops and report very favorably on the season's work, considering the scarcity of water which came at a very critical time.

All the hay is in the stacks, grain cut and the threshing machines turned at work, one farmer having already deposited 2,000 bushels of wheat at the mill.
