

EXPRESSIONS FROM THE PEOPLE.  
RELIGIOUS ANTAGONISM, ANCIENT AND MODERN.

HISTORY Repeating itself.

CITY OF MEXICO, Jan. 29, 1885.

From the earliest period of the world's history strife and contention have existed between man and man, caused generally by adherence to different religious views and tenets towards others. At different ages of the world, God has had a people whom He acknowledged as His people and with whom He had covenants. Inasmuch as He made Himself personally known to them, it appears, was a chosen instrument of God, the Saviour, who delivered the children of Israel. The Pharisee, the "wise men," however, did not so consider him. They could not tolerate his doctrine, for it differed materially from their own. They frequently said it was erroneous and repulsive. Yes, as Senator Morgan says, "the Devil's nostrils drift to the time of Christ who find certain religious bodies here were."

PERSECUTED AND HUNTED DOWN

by the wise men, and were thrown into dark dungeons, lions dens, fire furnaces, etc. They were declared to be heretics and pray to God contrary to the effects that were made against them. Christ came, and at twelve years of age came to Jerusalem, and taught the people, teaching and talking to them. He established a religion among them with apostles, prophets, etc., as officers and leaders. These were chosen to carry the news from city to city, and it grew with wonderful rapidity. There was a oneness, a unity, a love, and oneness among them, and their influence became to be felt. The "wise men" viewed its growth and prosperity with alarm and apprehension, fearing that in time it would overshadow all other religions. The church, however, had been persecuted to save the morality and name of the nation, in their zeal for the welfare of humanity they crucified Christ, and put him to death. Shortly after this a number of apostles from the Church of Christ styled the Gnostics, came into public view and denied the divinity of Christ, and professed to have Scriptural knowledge. They proposed to obtain the greater portion of the world by Platonic philosophy, New Testament, and old Oriental theosophy. They introduced the philosophical ideas of other sects, and in the second century assumed the name of Ecclesiastes, on account of their many sects.

ORIGIN

was a philosopher, educated by the "wise men" and thought all religions meant about the same thing. The "wise men" were very zealous in their view, was to bring all sects and religions into harmony, by persuading pagans into an allegory, conveying their religious tenets to them, and then, on the other hand, by robbing Christianity of all its high and holy principles, he endeavored to make the extreme sects, like the Gnostics, Christians and pagans into one system. This he effectively accomplished, and what was called the "Catholic Church" in the year 313 A.D. (the Faust of the World, vol. I, p. 58, 51.)

History informs us that the Church of Christ, in the year 313 A.D., was very poor and very weak, almost afraid to show its face because of the oppression of the "wise men." The members of the church, however, were persecuted to save the name and honor of the church.
