Tintic Stocks Attracted Attention  
But Trading Was Dull All  
Along Line.

## BECK TUNNEL MOVES OFF.

But Later Recovers—Nothing Doing  
Among Unlisted—Closing  
Quotations.

The early sessions of the Salt Lake Stock & Mining Exchange today were not very animated. The trading was confined to fewer stocks than usual, yet the participation of Beck Tunnel brought the totals up pretty well. With two exceptions, the business was all done in the Tintic list. Beck Tunnel sold at the beginning, but recovered, closing on the sale of 700 shares at \$2.12½.

Colorado opened weak and likewise proved. Crown point did, also, but Sioux Consolidated continued sluggish and with little inclination to move forward. South Columbus dropped to \$2 a share, while Mountain Lake remained steady around 70 cents.

The unlisted stocks were inactive and no sales of any kind were reported. An effort was made to bring Ohio copper up at \$4.50, but failure was the result. However, the stock was offered at \$4.75. Utah Treasure Hill was some stronger and indications point to a higher market, particularly if the deal looking toward going through. The closing quotations and sales were:

## MINERS ENDORSE STRIKE.

Change Room Question Will Be Fought Out at Goldfield.

At the meeting of the Western Federation of Miners held last Tuesday night, the walkout of the miners of the Mohawk mine was endorsed, says a Goldfield special to the Tonopah Bonanza. This means that no union man affiliated with the miners' union can be employed on the famous Mohawk. Thirty-five miners employed on the Combination, another of the merger mines, also walked out, in consequence of the completion of the change room on that property.

The change room on the Red Top will be finished in about a week, when, it is supposed, the men will walk out from that property.

The action of the union does not look good to the people in the town, and it was a surprise to most of them. It is the general impression that the miners would not sustain the men of the Mohawk, for the reason that the installing of the change room was part of the contract under which work was resumed at the close of the long strike in the spring.

The operators say that there will be no change in their program and that the change rooms will have to stand, no matter what the action of the miners' union. This places a most serious phase on the situation for it is taken to mean that the Mohawk will resume work if not with their old men, with new hands.

## CONSTRUCTION AT GARFIELD PLANT

The Work of Enlarging Smelter Is Progressing at a Satisfactory Pace.

## READY BY THE END OF YEAR

Some Foundations Completed—New MacDougal Building—Capacity To Be Doubled.

It will probably be news to a good many to learn that the management of the Garfield Smelting construction a large force engaged in construction at the Garfield plant which is already producing close to 2,000,000 pounds of copper metal monthly out at the south end of the Great Salt Lake. The announcement was made a good many months ago that the plant would be increased in size and would ultimately handle more than as much again ore than it is handling at the present time.

The work of enlargement has been progressing for some little time and it was learned today that the foundations for the new MacDougal roaster building has been completed, those of the west extension of the main furnace are half finished, two of the converter stands have been completed, two others are under construction and in addition to this, the machine shop has been enlarged and numerous other improvements made along the lines previously outlined by those in charge of the enterprise.

The initial unit of the Garfield smelter was completed last year and for the past six months has been creating an average of 1,200 tons a day. The enlargement of the plant has been a matter of necessity owing to the rapid growth of the company's business which has been greatly augmented by the activity being displayed by the Boston Consolidated and Utah Copper companies at Bingham. Within a few months the time the demand for the smeltering capacity will be more apparent, especially so after the mills of the last named companies are completed and get down to business.

It is expected that the Garfield smelter in its enlarged form will be ready for commission by the beginning of the year, but is very doubtful indeed.
