NEWS OF THE DAY.

Hundreds of gold seekers are outfitting at and passing through Cheyenne for the Black Hills.

The Atlantic and Pacific Telegraph Company will reduce their tariff twenty to thirty per cent.

A Boston lawyer has been arrested for having in his possession a large amount of stolen bonds.

A Congressional council assembled in Henry Ward Beecher's church, this afternoon; one hundred and forty churches were represented.

THE ELECTION.

The municipal election yesterday passed off in a peaceful manner, very different from the riotous months ago, when the ring abettors permitted their passions and their whiskey to impel them on to violent, and even to riotous demonstrations against the municipal authorities. Indeed, the election yesterday proceeded with something of the orderly quietness generally characteristic of Utah elections, and which is normal to them when allowed to have their natural course, as drunken, abusive, violent and riotous demonstrations are characteristic of and normal to many communities outside of Utah.

There was but a small total vote polled yesterday, perhaps arising from the conviction on the part of the friends of the People's Ticket that it would easily secure an overwhelming majority. The highest number of votes polled on this ticket was 2,867, very much less than that at the last election.

The highest number of votes polled for the opposition ticket was 435, or a little more than one-fifth of the highest number on the People's Ticket, notwithstanding the energy and diligence of the friends of the opposition, and the boasted statement that the opposition canvassers "did their whole duty" and the ladies on that side of the house "never before showed so much spirit on an election day," which went to the polls en masse, which was certainly not the case with the friends of the People's Ticket, though in all probability it would have been if the voters had believed there was any necessity for it. As it is, the people of this city may congratulate themselves upon the triumph of the People's Ticket, and the election of citizens to office who have the true interests of the community at heart.

Praying for Deliverance, Etc.

WASHINGTON, 13.—The chaplain, in the opening prayer, said: "We humbly beseech Thee to pardon us, we humbly pray Thee to help us out of the stagnation of business and out of the dreary misery of the poor. May the moral character of this people shine forth as the sun."

Sherman, from the committee on finance, reported adversely on the Senate bill to authorize deposits by clerks and other officers of courts in banks and other designated depositories; placed on the calendar with the adverse report, at the request of Wright.

The chair laid before the Senate a communication from the Secretary of War, enclosing the final report of Major G. K. Warren, corps of engineers, on the improvement of water communication between the Mississippi and Lake Michigan, along the valley of the Fox and Wisconsin rivers, and referred to the committee on transportation roads.

Hitchcock, from the committee on Territories, reported favorably on the Senate bill to enable the people of New Mexico to form a constitution and State government, and for the admission of the State into the Union, with a written report; ordered printed, and the bill was placed on the calendar.

Merrill, from the committee on appropriations, called up the House bill making appropriations for the payment of claims, and other purposes for the year ending June 30, 1877.
