LEHI.

WANT LOCAL INDUSTRIES.

Commercial Club Offers Inducements To Manufacturers—Need of a Hotel.

Lehi, Utah Co., Dec. 11.—At the meeting of the Lehi Commercial club Saturday evening, a resolution was unanimously adopted, asking all local manufacturers and individuals to make every effort to insure that the Commercial club would furnish a free site to any manufacturer's industry that would locate in Lehi, and that the members and citizens would help in other substantial ways in assisting in getting the industry to locate here. The secretary of the club has instructed to write to the Illinois firm, which proposes to establish a glass factory in Utah, telling them of the above resolution and of the advisability of locating its works here, as Lehi has the same freight rate from the east as Salt Lake City, and has the very best of sand and lime rocks, which would be used in this industry.

Lehi's hotel service is inadequate in view of the needs of the town, and after discussing this matter, the secretary was instructed to spend some money to advertise conditions in the city. Inducements to a good hotel man to locate here in Lehi, with over 3,000 people, is conceived to be a good hotel town, and the man who would start up a business here would receive most substantial assistance from all the business men.

FARMERS' INSTITUTE.

A Farmers' institute will be held here Dec. 20, under the direction of the Agricultural college of Lehi, and the tabernacle there will be two sessions, one in the afternoon and one in the evening, to which all the farmers of the north end of Utah county are especially invited. The following professors and teachers of the college will participate: Prof. McLaughlin, "Irrigation and Drainage"; Prof. Bell, "Soil Surveying"; Prof. Jenkins, "General Farming"; Miss Wyant, "Literature for the Young"; and Miss Cotey, "Domestic Science." There will also be musical numbers from Lehi, American Fork and Pleasant Grove, and talks by the prominent farmers and stock raisers who will entertain the visitors at the club rooms, and will have charge of the arrangements for this institute. Prof. Yoder will attend, but his subject has not yet been announced.

ANNIVERSARY SERVICES.

On Dec. 24 the heating apparatus will be installed in the tabernacle, and a special afternoon meeting will be held in commemoration of the one hundredth birthday of the Prophet Joseph Smith. In the evening a special program will be given under the auspices of the Mutual Improvement associations of the four wards.

OAXACA COLONY WRECKED BY FLOOD

Three-Fourths of Thriving Little Town Washed Away by Merciless Torrent.

MANY FAMILIES HOMELESS.

No Lives Were Lost—Disaster Less Severe in Colonia Morelos—Heavy Flood at Diaz.

Cecilia Oaxaca, Sonora, Mexico, Nov. 27.—One of the most destructive floods in the history of the colony swept through this place from 11 a. m. to 7 p. m. here today, and the people of this prosperous little colony were despoiled and left destitute. In the moment of panic, almost on all and everywhere was green and hard; at dark everything was in ruins.

But few men and two teams were at home or at hand, and the water of the Barispe river rose so rapidly that but few houses could be saved. Organic stores and all kinds of furniture, with the houses in the merciless torrent.

The water must have been 20 feet higher than in any previous flood, but scarcely a mark is left to show where they stood. Others, where the water was not so deep, were turned out and dried with mud. It had hard everything was in ruins.
