To the President and Board of Directors of the Territorial Insane Asylum:
Gentlemen—I have the honor to submit my annual report with details of the operation of the Asylum, for the fiscal year ending November 25, 1890. Appended to the report will be found tabular statements of the movements of patients, also similar statements of the receipts, expenses, and disbursements of the board and treatment account.

The above summary shows that the permanent population of the Asylum is increased by one at the end of the year. This is due to the admission of three new patients, one male and two females, and therefore entitled to more than one judge. The meeting was convened during the session of election.
