NEWS OF THE DAY.

A new Pacific Steamship Company is talked of in the East, to be run exclusively in the interest of the railway companies between Philadelphia, New York, Boston and San Francisco. Governor Leland Stanford is spoken of as the one who will give the new company. Mr. Russell Sage, President of the Pacific Mail Company, says the company now existing between the company and the Trans-continental railroads is injuring all parties concerned, and he claims that the P. M. Co. are willing to do anything to put an end to the difficulties.

The New Orleans special of the Chicago Inter-Ocean, a republican, and consequently a carpet-bag, organ, sends extravagant rumors of the movements and doings of the "White Leaguers" in various localities in the South. In the parishes of St. Martin and Iberia he says they have three cannons, are armed with Winchester rifles and have rations furnished by the U. S. Government for distressed Louisiana at the time of the great overflow. During the last three weeks he says that fifty-seven, negroes and whites, have been murdered in the vicinity of the parishes, and at least thirty in and about Coushatta. The registration officers in the northern portion of the State refuse to serve because of the insecurity of life, and the regular police of Shreveport have all been discharged and "White Leaguers" appointed in their places, all of which, if true, would create a somewhat perilous situation of affairs, but as the story emanates from carpet-bag sources, there is little doubt that most of it, if not all, is manifestly untrue. No justification to intended raids by them now that U. S. troops have been placed at their disposal. "Raid and ruin" is their motto, and with government troops they will carry it out if possible.

Two geological professors who accompanied the Custer Black Hill Expedition, say they saw no signs of any auriferous quartz during the trip, and they receive with great allowance all reports about discoveries of the precious metals by any of the party.

It is said of one of the professors anything at stake in the pecuniary affairs of the Old Adams Express Co., they will find in to-day's telegraphic news a ruling of Judge Barrett, of the New York Supreme Court, which may be of interest to them.

The steamship *Alexandria*, which was sunk in the Mersey on Wednesday, has been raised and placed in the dry dock for repairs.

Five per cent of the volunteers recently drafted for the Spanish army in Cuba, have been ordered into active service until next April; this adds thirty-five hundred to the Spanish army.

The ship *Exine* was burned while on the voyage from Shields, in the north of England, to Aden, a port on the Red Sea. It was crewed by three hundred men, and after a voyage of over eleven hundred miles, reached the Island of St. Helena. The third boat has not been heard from.

The Carlisle, in an official dispatch published in the Paris newspapers, acknowledge firing upon the German gunboats *Abatross* and *Vandalion*, but they say the Germans were attempting to land armed men at the time.

The Democrats of Michigan, in convention at Kalamazoo, had in their platform resolutions demanding the repeal of the "salary grab" and "press gag" laws.

The Commissioner of the General Land Office has ruled that in applications for patents on the mining laws, proofs of citizenship are necessary only on the part of the applicant, and not of the original locators of the interest.

The call for a Republican convention to be held at Chattanooga, Tenn., Oct. 18, is said to be being widely signed by prominent republicans in all sections. The call invites republicans from all parts of the country to attend the convention.

Considerable excitement has been caused at Green Point, L. I., over the disappearance of a three-months-old baby, the child of a wealthy citizen. It was taken out for a ride by a disreputable man, who did not return till next day, and then without the baby, her story being that some men had stolen it from her.

A fire at Farmington, N. H., on Wednesday night, did \$30,000 damage. Part of the property burned was a shoe factory, employing two hundred hands out of employment.

The Republican and Tax Union Committees are in session at Columbia, S. C.

The fastest cup time on record was run by "Lizzie Lucas" at the Buffalo race yesterday—two and a half minutes in four minutes and twenty-eight and a half seconds.

Two of the negroes recently taken by a mob from Trenton, Tenn., are now in jail at Memphis, Tenn., and several parties, supposed to have been implicated in that outrage, are under arrest.

In the 10th Ohio Congressional district, yesterday, E. H. Hurlbert was nominated for Congress, in opposition to Garrettsville.

The latest telegraphic news this afternoon states that the three-months-old baby, stolen from Green Point, L. I., was found in a starving condition in New York yesterday, and was taken to a hospital and died.

Twenty persons were killed and more injured this morning in a collision on the Eastern Railway, near Norwich, England.

A LION'S CAGE ON FIRE.—Just before the performance came off at the circus at Palmyra, Friday night, an unfortunate accident occurred. While one of the employees was engaged in holding a lion, he slipped from his hand, falling upon the lion, and igniting the combustible liquid. The lion ran into a stream of flame, causing the animal to retire before it and to crouch at the other side. At this juncture another employee thoughtlessly went inside the cage, with a view to its extinguishment. At the shoulders through the lion's head, he raised himself upon his hind legs, and, with a roar, sprang upon the unfortunate man, just as he had got fairly on the lion's back, tearing the flesh from his face, his arm, so horribly lacerating him that but little hope of his recovery. He was nothing but a mass of blood and flesh, which would have killed him in a few

moments more had not the master of the beast intervened with whip in hand and the animal subsided as bay. The lion was considered the tamest of the kind known to circus men. Having been greatly roused by the fire, he was, however, ready to attack anything that came in his way. To add to this, the employee was not known to the lion, and needlessly endangered his life by the intrusion, though it was for the unappreciative animal's benefit.—*Nashville Banner.*

REVERSING HIS DECISION.

We ought not to let pass the fair circumstance of our respected Chief Justice reversing one of his decisions last Monday, in a divorce case. If we notice it now, it may be better late than never.

When a person becomes convinced that he has done a wrong thing, and he immediately undoes it, it is a sign that he is not incorrigible, but that he is open to conviction, repentance and amendment.

Now this reversal of one of his own decisions, which he had before a favorable indication for his honor, the Chief Justice, and it affords us special pleasure to place it on record to his credit in his account current with the people. When the Judge does a good thing he ought to have credit for it, and we shall be happy to accord to him all the credit which we believe he deserves for it.

There is hope of the Chief Justice when he shows that he is not above correcting an error of his own. It is one of the noblest traits to be forward to make right that which we have made wrong, and we truly rejoice to see such a trait in any man, whether he stand among the ranks of friends or foes, and more especially when that man occupies a prominent position in the community.

Now that our honored Chief Justice has given evidence that he can retract at all, it will be natural to suppose that he can retract still further. If he can reverse one erroneous decision, what should hinder him from reversing other erroneous decisions? That he has given other erroneous decisions there is a very general and strong belief. In view of it is patent, for almost his decisions, made in Utah, which have been appealed to the Supreme Court of the United States, have been by that court decided erroneous, and consequently have been reversed. Probably many others which he has made here, if they were to go before that august and final tribunal, would share the same reversitory fate.

It is not too much, therefore, to presume that his honor will yet have his mind enlightened and his judicial sight cleared sufficiently to discover that he has made mistakes in more decisions than the one which he has himself reversed, and those which the Supreme Court of the United States has reversed, and that he will yet reverse a few more. One of those which most needs reversing, in justice and upon its own merits, is that, or it may be those, in which he has decided in favor of men who believe in or practice the marriage believed in and practiced by many of the most exalted and revered characters who figure in Bible history, and which has been held to be honorable by four-fifths of the human race from the beginning until now. Let his honor try his hand at reversing his decision or decisions in that matter, and we have a firm assurance that, if he proves successful, he will find his liberal-minded reversory action infinitely more to the credit of both his head and his heart than his restrictive, narrow-minded decisions already recorded. While we give credit to his honor for the good he has done, let us at least hope that he will not get weary in doing, but will press forward to reverse those things that he may be fairly entitled to more credit in that line. It really would be too bad for him to succumb with the first victory over himself. The initiative, successful as it has proved, surely ought not to be the grave of his good intentions and redeeming endeavors. If he will kindly permit us to encourage and stimulate him, in a friendly sort of way, in his new and noble efforts in this reformatory line, we would commend him to that favorite law of his favorite Methodist devotees—

Press forward, press forward, the prize is in view.
A crown of bright glory is awaiting for you.

Conditioned always upon the indispensable proviso that he persevere in well doing and endeavor faithfully in the same to the end. Otherwise nothing counts for him, but all goes for naught.
