CONSERVATIVE LEGISLATION.

Utah has acquired a reputation for conservative legislation, whether or not she altogether deserves it in recent years. In the main, however, the disposition of legislative enactments has been against anything of a radical or revolutionary character. This disposition has given confidence in the State for investments of various kinds and has proved efficient as a capital stock for the development of the great resources of this locality.

Experience has shown the wisdom of this conservatism; and now that the first Legislature of the new State is in session, the careful policy of the past ought to be given further emphasis. It would be disastrous for the lawmakers to launch out in schemes of a revolutionary and uncertain character, even in response to popular clamor, which does not always indicate the wise course. Every measure adopted should be carefully examined, and new ideas or schemes should not be endorsed except with caution and in such a gradual manner as to give no opportunity for unpleasant effects.

One class of legislation in which special conservatism should be displayed is that relating to railway transportation rates. We are fully aware of the fact that railroads have not treated Utah fairly on all occasions, and of the further fact that there is a popular demand for them to be brought in time. We are also aware that the cause for complaint is chiefly outside of the State, and cannot be remedied by local legislation. Local railway representatives have generally manifested a disposition to be fair, and while sometimes they have been overruled by higher officials outside the State who did not seem to fully understand conditions here, through them many arrangements of a markedly benevolent character have been entered into. And as against all railway shippers that may be named, there stands the undeniable fact that the roads have accomplished a vast amount for the development of the country and conveniences of the people, and none of them heretofore seems to be particularly heavy dividends paid, since all have had more or less experience in the hands of receivers.

In this connection we invite attention to a brief letter of a congressional in another column, who, while admitting that grievances exist, urges caution in the legislation that proposes to correct them. On our own part we believe it is the determination of the legislators to act with due caution, and yet be courageous in the performance of a plain duty. But influences of various kinds are brought to bear upon them, and in some respects radical measures are demanded for alleged abuses. In this situation there is less danger from too few laws than from overdoing the business; and if the first State Legislature shall adjourn without having adopted anything of a radical nature, but with a record for persistent conservatism, whatever talents it may display will be more readily forgiven and forgotten than if a different course were pursued.
