

FIRST DAY OF THE ANNUAL SHOOT

Interesting Contest Among Crack Shots Now Going on at Ogden.

POCATELLO MAN WINS FIRST.

Good Scores Made Difficult on Account of Wind Blowing Across the Traps.

Fifty expert shots participated in the big shoot at Ogden yesterday. It was the first day of the annual tournament of the Idaho-Utah Sportsmen's association, and proved successful in every way with the exception that the weather was rather cold and the wind blowing across the traps kept the scores down. There were six sets of traps working all afternoon and today there are others in commission. In the first event a perfect score was made and this was the only one of the day. In the second event, each made 30 out of a possible 40, and the tie is being shot off today. L. A. Lehrbas of Pocatello won the final event of the day, but one bird.
